Guest Speaker

Jack Ball introduced Mr. Peter Kim, Industrial Sales Team Leader for Eaton Canada. Peter used an excellent power point presentation to review the evolution of electric vehicles. He noted that electric vehicles have been around for a very long time and were now being produced by almost every major auto manufacturer. Peter indicated that it is estimated by 2018, 10% of the vehicles in Canada will be powered electrically and in order to accommodate the increasing demand, many local governments now require new installations to include provisions for electric vehicle charging. Peter reviewed the features of the various types of chargers available and also provided a brief overview of the Code requirements included in Section 86 for electric vehicle charging systems.
